

2024 SUMMER SCHOOL

DATES:

May 28th-31st, June 3rd-6th, 10th-13th, 17th, 18th, 20th, and 24th-27th

TIME:

7:30am-11:00am or 11:30am-3:00pm (students may work online at any time of the day that works for them, but teachers will be available during the above times)

CHROMEBOOKS:

All students who need a Chromebook for Summer School will need to pick it up at the WHS Help Desk during these hours: May 28th-31st 7:30am-2:00pm June 3rd and 4th 8:00am-12:00pm

DETAILS:

WHS will hold summer school again this year using an online program called Edgenuity. Certified teachers will be assigned to students to assist through coursework and troubleshoot technology questions. Once Summer School begins, students will be able attend tutoring with their instructor by entering through the West Wing entrance during the summer school hours listed above. On or before the first day of Summer School, students will receive an email from their teacher on how to log in and begin their course work. Communication with students will occur via email and phone, if parental permission is granted. Students will be expected to stay on pace with course completion (ie 25% should be completed by June 6th, 50% should be completed by June 13th, 75% should be completed by June 20th, 100% of the course should be completed by June 27th). Students who are not keeping pace with course requirements may be required to attend tutoring sessions (in person or via zoom).

*EOCs: Students enrolled in English II, Algebra I, Algebra II, Government, or Biology will be required to take an EOC.

PLEASE NOTE:

- -PHYSICAL EDUCATION If your child is signing up for PE this summer, the class is held from 7:30am-11:00am on each of the dates listed above. To earn PE credit your child must be present 17 of the 19 attendance days. There will be no make-up sessions.
- -DRIVER'S EDUCATION If your child is signing up for Driver's Education this is a non-credit bearing course. They will need to be present on the first five days of instruction from 7:30am until 11:00am and then will schedule a time with the instructor for driving. Students must be 15 years of age to take Driver's Ed. There are limited seats for Driver's Education. Once that maximum has been met you will still be allowed to sign up however you will be placed on a wait list in the event a student decides to drop prior to the first day of instruction.

Enrollment for SDOW students will be from April 1st-May 24th.

On May 15th, depending on available spots, enrollment may open up to students outside of the SDOW.
